# General Membership Meeting September 27, 2016, 6:00pm

<u>Call to Order -</u> Mrs. Hering and Deb Christiansen called the meeting to order at 6:05pm

1. Band Director Report - Mrs. Hering reported

### a) Fall Events:

- Past events for this school year of; Adventure Park Fundraiser, Car Wash,
   Marching Band Camp, Pajamarama, and etc., have been successfully completed.
- Upcoming events:
  - ◆ Rummage Sale; October 29<sup>th</sup>, 8am-1pm, in the CHS cafeteria (setup and donation drop-off is October 28<sup>th</sup>, starting at 2:30pm. Chair Pam Trottier reported that the CHS Girls Volleyball team will be holding a craft show the same day in the CHS Fieldhouse, they will cross promote with us. Pam will purchase 25 promotional yard signs. Mrs. Hering noted that on set-up day student helpers will be away for the Frost Spirit Assembly Field Trip and will be back at 3:30pm to help.
  - ◆ Hungry Howie's Pizza Fundraiser; Order forms out September 30<sup>th</sup>, forms and money due October 12<sup>th</sup>, and delivery set for October 28<sup>th</sup>. Chair Lianne Helms reported that selling price for certificates is \$5 each and that she will post advertisements.
  - ◆ Poinsettias and Greenery Fundraiser; Order forms out end of October / first week in November, forms and money due November 10<sup>th</sup>, and delivery will coincide with Fall Band Concert on November 17<sup>th</sup>. Co-chairs are Kathi Withun,

Liz Jarvis and Kim Gardner. Kathi reported they will make contact with supplier for pricing to get things rolling.

- ◆ Stage Decorating for December 6<sup>th</sup> Holiday Band Concert; Help will be needed for stage decorating set for November 21<sup>st</sup> and/or 22<sup>nd</sup> available times are from 7:30am to 8:30pm both days (there will be no CAPA conflicts). Goal is to find help, sometime in October, to clear out any unused items to sell at Rummage Sale.
- ♦ Concert Ticket Booth and miscellaneous tasks; On track with signups out for help that is needed.

## b) Winter and Spring Events:

- ♦ MSBOA Band and Orchestra Festival and Concessions; Upcoming in March.

- ◆ Marching Band Uniform Collection; Collection of uniforms will happen sooner this year (maybe in November or December) to prepare for packing for slated school improvements.

#### c) Financials:

• Budget Report will be handed out next meeting. Some things mentioned; Marching Band costs are all on track with some outstanding camp payments that will be followed up with, Adventure Park Fundraiser wasn't as profitable as hoped but plan to try again next year for-seeing a more successful turnout, Amazon Smile brought in a small amount to date, Car Wash Fundraiser was on track raising the goal expected, Pajamarama was very successful with a record amount raised, Band Store Apparel and Decal sales are on-going with outcome of monies raised to come, purchases of instruments and uniforms are on track with the budget.

#### 2. Additional Items Discussed-

a) <u>Scrip Fundraising Program:</u> Chair Nancy Goraj reported, the first sale started in September and plans for future monthly sales are set. Discussion about boosters placing a 'Holiday Order' for having cards on hand to sell at concerts, all agreed to do so, Nancy will follow-up.

- b) <u>Dine-out Fundraisers:</u> Melissa ONeil to set-up dine-out opportunities and is checking with different businesses to set dates with the objective to have one a month.
- c) School Bond Improvements Pertaining to Band Program: Mrs. Hering reported that Churchill school improvements are slated to begin summer of 2017. The entire band region must be packed up by end of this school year with volunteers needed to help pack in Spring. Plans are to purchase a trailer, which will be owned by the Band program, allowing for storage of ladders and such during school improvements and used for future Band event needs. Band program classroom will temporarily be relocated during renovations until done in November of 2018. Most Band program events (concerts, Pajamarama, etc.) will still be held with other location arrangements being made.
